Can A Modern Man Believe In Hell?

"And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments..."

- Luke 16:23

he doctrine of hell is a salute to the freedom of the will. If there were no hell, then man would not be a free moral agent. For if every man has to go to heaven, then heaven would become hell to those who do not want to go. The enjoyment of anything is conditioned by the nature of the person. If you would take a genuine Christian and place him in a night club where people are engaged in gradual self-destruction, the Christian would be in hell; though for the unsaved man, such a place would be heaven. On the other hand, if you

were to place an unsaved man, carnal and selfish in his make up, in a prayer meeting, though to the Christian that would be heaven, to him the prayer meeting would be hell. For an unsaved man to be forced to go to heaven when he doesn't want to go, heaven would become hell for him.

When I was in my teens, I preached a strong sermon on hell in the course of a revival. A very suave and cultured lady came and spoke to me after the service. She pleaded with me that I not preach on that subject again. She reminded me that such a view was not consistent with the love of God for all men. God could never allow such a place to exist, and to preach such a doctrine would do injustice to the mercy of God for us. I then responded by asking her what I should preach. She replied that I major on the Sermon on the Mount. In that sermon is all the material for the minister. She did not know her Bible. She was stunned when I told her that one could not preach the Sermon on the Mount without preaching on hell. Then I showed her Matthew 5:29, 30, where Jesus said, "If thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell. And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell."

In the attempt to discourage ministers from dwelling upon this dreadful reality, I have heard people refer to them as being "Hell, fire, and damnation preachers." This ought to be a compliment to the conscientiousness of the minister. That proves that he is declaring the whole counsel of God. That means that he is not trimming his sails to catch the breeze of passing popularity.

Woe unto the minister who succumbs to the wants of the people instead of the will of God. We ought to obey God rather than men. Men didn't call the preacher into the ministry; God called him. His first loyalty is to the Lord. You might as well make fun of a medical doctor by saying that he believes in cancer, tuberculosis, and polio. Why, certainly he does, and he would not be true to his practice if he disregarded these dreadful realities simply to soothe the minds of his patients.

I began my ministry at the age of thirteen. As a youngster, in the course of preparing sermons, I would think some thoughts that for the moment would frighten me. Some of these thoughts I never voiced in the course of the message. I thought that perhaps it would be better to store them and let time judge their validity. I want to express a thought now that I felt was true in my teens, but then I surmised that mature reflection would eliminate it. However, after these many years in the ministry, I find it to be true. This is it, if a man believes that there is no hell, he is going there when he dies. For if there is no hell, then Christ is a liar and He cannot be our Redeemer. For a man to say that there is no hell makes Christ a liar, and He cannot be that man's Saviour. It is not a pleasant thought that man can so sin so as to be separate from God forever. But the word of God is infallible, and its teaching is inerrant. We may not understand the ramifications of this tragic truth, but if we want to eliminate its deadly results on us, then let's quit arguing about it and head for the cross.

I. THE REALITY OF HELL-

Jesus did most of the teaching on the doctrine of hell. He said more about it than any other person in the Bible.

- After the parable of the tares He said, "The tares shall be case into the furnace of fire" (Matthew 13:42). He was referring to unsaved people.
- After the parable of the fish He said, "The unsaved shall be cast into a place where there is weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth" (Matthew 13:50).
- He called hell "outer darkness" in the case of the unprofitable servant (Matthew 25:30).
- everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels" (Matthew 25: 41).
- He said, "These shall go away into everlasting punishment" (Matthew 25:46).
- He told the Pharisees that when they made a proselyte, they made him a child of hell (Matthew 23:15).
- He said to them, "Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can you escape the damnation of hell?" (Matthew 23:33).

No one can forget the realistic description that Christ gives concerning hell in the sixteenth chapter of Luke. Remember, this is not a parable. Jesus tore a page out of the book of eternity and gave us a picture of life on the other side of the grave. The unsaved man went to hell immediately after his death (v. 23).

- He could see in hell (v. 23).
- He could speak in hell (v. 24).
- He could feel in hell (v. 24).
- He could think in hell (v. 25).
- taught that men go there for not repenting (v. 30).

The principle of hell is not only written in the Bible, it is inherent in everything that we see around us. For every good thing house, it makes food edible, it produces energy for commerce. city in the form of an atomic bomb. Water has its heaven side – a cold drink of water, a running brook, a swim on a hot day. But water has its hell side. Some years ago in Galveston, Texas, the hand of nature reached into the Gulf and poured water on the land and hundreds died. That's the hell side of water.

Marriage can be heaven or hell. A beautiful home, where two people love each other supremely, is heaven. A home where two people wrangle and endure one another is hell.

The doctrine of hell is woven into the warp and woof of our existence.

The Bible teaches that there will be degrees in hell. Everyone will not suffer alike. When I began my ministry 26 years ago, I would exhort the sinner that if he did not plan to go to heaven, his wisest course would be to live it up. Pay no attention to the moral laws; fill the cup of iniquity to the brim, because there would be no good times in hell. But more mature reflection has changed my views. Now I say, if the sinner is not going to heaven, live a good life, pay your debts, be ethical, be moral, for the hell of the good man will not be the same as the hell of the wicked man.

Jesus clearly taught that this was so. Speaking about the scribes who devour widows' houses, He said, "These shall receive the greater damnation" (Mark 12:40). And when He was upbraiding - He says to the unsayed, "Depart from me, ve cursed, into the cities, He said, "Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. But I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the day of judgment, than for you" (Matthew 11:21,22).

But let me say this, and let's not forget it, that men and women do not go to hell for anything that they do on the moral level. If men went to hell for getting drunk, God is unjust. It would be like putting a man in the penitentiary for life for stealing a loaf of bread. If men go to hell for committing adultery or for murder, then God is unjust. It would be like sending a man to the gas chamber for running a red light. Men are not going to hell for any sin that they commit on the moral level. Men will experience hell on this earth for their sin; a bitter conscience and dull regrets testify to this for those who do wrong. Men go to hell for rejecting Christ. Jesus placed salvation on the level with man's rejection of the way of salvation. Now there will be murderers in hell and thieves and good men, but they are not there for their sins; they are there because they would not avail themselves of the remedy of The man was conscious in hell; he was not engaging in soul redemption. II. THE RESIDENTS OF HELL -

The child of God will not be there. No one who has ever been saved will be in hell. God will discipline His own in His own sovereign way, but He will not send any of His children to hell. Some years ago I was preaching on this subject and the next day I received a telephone call. The gentleman at the other end of the line told me that he did not find my sermon logical. He said, "I

they disobey me and I have to discipline them. But no matter how they hurt me, I would never send them to a place of eternal punishment. I am just an earthly father; God's love is as superior to mine as the mountains are above the earth and I don't believe that God would send any of His children to hell."

I agreed with him and said, "My friend, I did not say that God would send His children to hell. I agree with you. That is why I believe in 'once saved always saved.' I said that God would send the devil's children to hell so that they can be with their papa."

"Oh," he said, "don't you believe that all men are God' children? Didn't He make us?"

"Jesus didn't believe that all men are God's children." replied. "In John 8:44, Jesus told the good moral Pharisees, 'Ye are of your father the devil.' So Satan has some children I believe that God made us, but He also made snakes and buzzards— is He their father? There's a difference between creatorhood and fatherhood. God is the Creator of life, but the Father only of those who have been born into His family. None of God's children will be in hell."

The open sinner will be there. We are told that men who live without Christ will be there because they rejected Jesus. The drunkard and the murderer and the liar will be there. The man who lived as if there were no God, no Christ, no church, no Ten Commandments, no cross, no Holy Spirit, no heaven, no hell, wil be there. Not because of his sins, for the cross could have taken care of those, but because of his willful rebellion against Christ.

Man is the only creature that defied God. Everything else in nature obeys His voice. When God said, "Let there be light," it was so. When God said, "Let fish swim in the sea, birds fly in the air, beasts roam in the field," it was so. When God said to a fig tree, "Wither and die," it was so. But man can shake a fist of dust in the face of God and rebel against His will and go to hell. God does not want any man to go to hell. When an unsaved man dies, God must stand by the coffin and say, "I didn't plan it that way."

"As I live," saith the Lord, "I do not delight in the death of the wicked." The Lord willeth that none should perish, but that all should come unto repentance. God is interested in the salvation of every person upon the face of the earth. His interest is manifested in nature, in man, in the Bible, in the cross, in the church, and God continually insists that man should come unto Him and be saved

The good moral man will be there. The Pharisees were good moral men, but the Lord told them that the drunkard and the harlot will be in heaven ahead of them (Matthew 21:31). Men are not saved by being good. The best in human goodness is like filthy rags in the sight of God. The Lord can accept nothing short of perfection. God is all that, and man can never be that. The Lord does not disparage human goodness; it is fine on the moral and human level. The divine ire is provoked when a fragile human attempts to substitute human goodness for divine righteousness.

We often say that man was made in the image of God, but this is not actually so. Adam was made in the image of God, but the

> The unsaved church member will be there. Men are not converted by the reading of the label. The reality of Christ must be inside the bottle. If the devil cannot keep you from being religious, then he will suggest that you substitute church membership for eternal salvation. Many people reject Jesus by joining a church. The church is wonderful and has its place, but it is not identical with salvation any more than a wedding ring is marriage. The ring symbolizes marriage, but it is not marriage. The scribes and the priests and the Levites were religious men, but they were not Christians. Judas was religious, but he wasn't saved, There is no substitute for "Ye must be born again."

> The procrastinator will be there. This is the man who had good intentions. He came to church, he listened, but he postponed decision to a mythical tomorrow. This man was not against the church, and he did not pride himself in his moral achievements. He knew full well the implications of the gospel message. He knew full well that redemption is rooted in Christ, not in conduct. He was in the courtship period with Jesus, but he never got married to Christ. The seed of the Scripture had been sown in the soil of the soul. It had been warmed by the rays of divine love, and watered by the tears of human concern. He did not deride salvation nor vilify its message. He just waited. He said, "Tomorrow." Oh, friends, there is no promise in the Bible of a tomorrow salvation. "Now is the accepted time, now is the day of salvation." God's clock says "now"; the devil's clock says "tomorrow."

III. THE REDEMPTION FROM HELL -

The purpose of the Crucifixion is to reveal the love of God and reflect the horrible nature of rejecting Christ. Some surmise that there can be no hell since God's love is a proven fact in the realm of human experience. But the love of God is made evident through the cross. The only way that anyone could accuse God of not having love would be for there to be no way out of hell. God doesn't allow our sins to be enough to send us to hell. For although sin is wicked and sordid, some would find reasons for sin in the light of their environment.

Sin is real, and it hurts, and sometimes it hurts for a lifetime, and it is no respecter of persons. It will hurt the saint as well as sinners, but because of the cross, it is not sufficient to send a man

If a man were sent to hell for drunkenness, he could plead at the bar and say, "My father drank and my grandfather drank. They made me drunk when I was a little boy. As I grew, every time I had troubles, I tried to solve them through drink." But God would say, "I foresaw that, and since My Son died on the cross, sin cannot send the soul to hell. But if you reject My Son, if you can stoop low enough to reject crucified love, and since your rejection

Then, after three days, I would come to the patient's house, tired and weary, and I would say to him, "My friend, I have good news for you. I have secured the remedy for you. I mortgaged and borrowed everything I had. I will spend the rest of my life paying it back. Look! I have secured healing for you! Now take it and you will be well."

Suppose the patient would take the bottle with the expensive fluid, look at it for a moment, then dash the bottle on the floor, and the liquid would run in every direction. Could he raise his finger in the doctor's face and say, "Doc, if I die, it will be your fault"? We would say that a man like that deserves to die. How, my friends, can sinners push God's remedy aside and blame Him for not loving them because a hell exists. A hell does exist, but so does the remedy, and God pity the wickedness of the hard heart that makes light of that provision that cost God His only begotten Son on a cruel cross. We would say that any man who refuses that remedy deserves to die forever in the pits of hell.

We do not know what hell is. The Bible calls it "outer darkness...weeping and wailing and gnashing of teeth...the bottomless pit...a place where memory burns for ever...eternal dying but never dead." But I think the summation of all of these is revealed by what Christ said when dying on the cross. He became sin for us and on the cross suffered hell for every man. In the midst of that experience, He cried, "My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?"

That's what hell is. It is eternal separation from God. How horrible! To be forsaken from God forever. To suffer eternal lonesomeness.

□ GETTYS PURCHASE \$5.5 MILLION HOME IN **NASHVILLE** - The profit for contemporary worship music can be massive. Keith and Kristyn Getty have purchased a \$5.5 million mansion in Nashville. This information was provided to us by a Re-Max agent based on information available online. The Gettys partner with Stuart Townend in Getty-Townend Music (GTM). The Getty-Townend hymn "In Christ Alone" has become one of the most famous hymns ever written, with an estimated 40 to 50 million people singing it in church services each year. The Gettys host massive, rocking music programs at Nashville's Opry House. forever what Christ suffered on the cross during the hours of Purposefully bridging sacred and contemporary music, they are drawing large numbers of "fundamentalists" into the contemporary in Galilee, rejection by Israel, corrupt trial, beating, crucifixion,

Music's Rejoice Hymns. Twenty-nine of their songs are featured in Hymns Modern and Ancient, published by Heart Publications. a ministry of Steve Pettit Evangelistic Association and compiled by Fred Coleman who heads up Bob Jones University's Department of Church Music. Both Crown Baptist College and West Coast Baptist College, the two of the largest independent Baptist Bible colleges, have performed Getty-Townend material in their services.

Since the Gettys have no clear boundaries in music or association, they are a bridge to the "broader church" with all of its great dangers. The Gettys don't believe in separation. They are positive-only, non-judgmental. They are representative of evangelicalism today, at the heart of which is "a renunciation of separatism," as Harold Ockenga stated it in the 1940s. The Gettys are people that say they love sound doctrine, but they don't separate from heresy, yoking with Roman Catholics and others who hold "damnable heresies" (II Peter 2:1). They don't draw clear lines as the Bible requires. They don't speak out against error and issue warnings as the Bible demands -

"Therefore I esteem all thy precepts concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way" (Psalm 119:128).

"And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them" (Ephesians 5:11).

"Now I beseech you, brethren, MARK THEM which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them" (Romans 16:17).

Instead, they keep everything on an upbeat, positive note Obviously this is a financially profitable path.

□ BILL GATES PROPOSES NEW RELIGION OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE - In a recent interview Microsoft founder Bill Gates proposed that AI (artificia intelligence) will solve the world's problems and possibly become a new religion. He said, "The potential positive path [of AI] is so good that it will force us to rethink how should we use our time You can almost call it a new religion or a new philosophy of how do we stay connected with each other, and not be addicted to these things that will make video games look like nothing in terms of the attractiveness of spending time on them. ... It's fascinating that issues of disease, and enough food, and of climate--if things go well--those will largely become solved problems" (Gates "Possibility, AI, and Humanity," Reid Hoffman's Possible podcast, Oct. 31, 2024).

Bill, whose net worth is said to be \$104 billion, is one of the prominent examples of Jesus' warning about a man who gains the whole world and loses his own soul. A voracious reader, he has neglected the one Book that really matters, which is the Bible. I is filled with prophecy, and the key to understanding Bible prophecy is the normal-literal method of interpretation. The same Book that described Christ's first coming in great detail--including His birthplace and lowly condition, miracles, preaching, ministry

mocking, sacrificial suffering and shedding of blood, death, Many of the Getty-Townend songs are included in Majesty resurrection, and ascension--describes Christ's second coming in just as much detail. That the prophecies of His first coming were fulfilled literally and perfectly is irrefutable evidence that the prophecies of His second coming will be fulfilled in like manner. His coming will be preceded by a time of global trouble greater than that of any previous time. In the very opening scenes of that time "there shall be famines, and pestilences" (Matthew 24:7-8), debunking Gates' fantasy that disease and lack of food will no longer be realities.

> As for climate, the earth will be the scene of massive destruction: "The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up. And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea; and the third part of the sea became blood; And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed. And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters; And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter" (Rev. 8:7-11).

That is only a small part of what Bible prophecy describes for the future. It is far wiser to trust the eternal words of Jesus Christ than any mere man.

We pray that Mr. Gates will bow his knees to the God who gives him "life, and breath, and all things" (Acts 17:25) and will put his confidence in Jesus Christ as the only Lord and Saviour (John 14:6) and in the great atonement He has made for mankind. □ CHRISTIAN SCHOOL BANNED AND BLACKLISTED AFTER GIRLS TEAM FORFEITS GAME OVER TRANS **OPPONENT** - A Vermont Christian girls basketball team is continuing to face major consequences after athletes refused to play against a team that had a biological male athlete who identifies as transgender. Mid Vermont Christian School, a K-12 institution in Quechee, Vermont, has been permanently banned from the Vermont Principals' Association (VPA), the body overseeing athletics in the state, because the school operates its athletic program consistent with its religious beliefs about sexuality and gender.

Last year, the Mid Vermont Christian School girls' basketball team declined to play against a team that included a biologically male player. "The Mid Vermont Christian Girls Basketball team qualified for their state-sponsored sports league playoff tournament," Ryan Tucker, an attorney at Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) representing the school, told CBN News. "And when they were looking at the seedings, they knew that the team that they were paired up against had a biological male who was professing to be female."

School officials reportedly contacted the VPA in advance to before her mind's eye. express safety and religious concerns about competing against a different competitor, so they were forced to forfeit the game. "And, as a result, the state punished them by kicking them, not just obviously out of that tournament, but out of the sports association entirely," Tucker said. "And so their girl sports season ended and they've been kicked out of that league."

The VPA also "blacklisted" the school from all state-sponsored events in the state including co-ed academic competitions like the Geo-Bee, Science and Math Fair, and Debate and Forensics League.

regarding gender, race, and disability awareness and said it would was paid, it was commonly stamped with the word "Tetelestai," refuse to let the school back into the league unless it updated its meaning *Paid in Full*. policies.

The ADF filed a federal lawsuit asking the league to reinstate the school into the league. U.S. District Court Judge Geoffrey Crawford denied them readmittance. In September, the school, students, and parents filed a lawsuit with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 2nd Circuit citing that VPA's actions violated the students' First Amendment rights. The lawsuit points out that while Mid Vermont has been penalized for their stance, three schools within the VPA have been allowed to forfeit games to avoid competing against a player who had a mask exemption, without consequences.

"The VPA cannot wield such unbridled discretion, accept when schools forfeit games for secular reasons, and then expel Mid Vermont for forfeiting a game based on its religious beliefs. Nor can the VPA exclude 'an otherwise eligible religious school from a public benefit solely because of its religious exercise," the opening brief states.

These types of forfeits are happening in other places too, including the collegiate level, and the fight for women's safety continues to be a battle on the field and in the courts.



Gesus Paid OtAll: The Story Behind The Hymn

Jesus Paid It All was written under unusual circumstances.

Did your mind ever wander during a Sunday service? Perhaps you started thinking about other things - maybe what occurred last week, or plans for the coming week or what you will be doing later that day. Something like that happened to the writer of a familiar hymn.

On a hot summer Sunday morning in 1865, Mrs. Elvina Hall (1820-1889) was found in her accustomed place in the church choir loft. But as the pious words of the Reverend Schrick's prayer droned on and on, her thoughts drifted to other things. She pondered the meaning of the cross, and the storied scene flashed

High upon a rocky crag, three crosses scarred the afternoon sky. biological male, but they were not given another option to play a On the outer gibbets, hung two notorious thieves. Below, Roman soldiers drank and gambled, waiting for death to overtake the poor wretches suspended above them. It was a public execution, but far more significant than they imagined at the time. Suddenly, the air grew dense and an eerie darkness invaded the scene.

As the soldiers gazed about them in superstitious dread, a triumphant cry pierced the gloom. It came from the figure on the centre cross. One word, in the Greek tongue: "Tetelestai!" Then He was dead. That shout of victory Christ uttered as He died is usually translated "It is finished!" (John 19:30). And that is precisely what the death of Christ accomplished.

"[He] bore our sins in His own body on the tree," says Peter in I Peter 2:24.

"He Himself is the propitiation [the full satisfaction of God's justice] for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world," (I John 2:2).

The groaning weight of all the world's sin was laid on Christ at Calvary. He bore it in our place.

As the pastor's prayer continued, Mrs. Hall took up her hymn book and, turning to a blank page inside the cover, she began to write. Afterward, she presented the pastor with some simple lines of poetry - not likely telling him when they were written! Glancing at them, the pastor was reminded of something that had happened just that week. The church organist, John Grape (1835-1915) had composed a new hymn tune, with no words in mind. He passed it on to Pastor Schrick, suggesting they might find a use for it in

Stepping into his study, the pastor laid Mrs. Hall's poem next to the lines of music. In surprise, he saw they fit one another like hand in glove. "Indeed, God works in mysterious ways!" he thought. (Little did he know!) The words and tune have been partners ever since, in the hymn, "Jesus Paid It All."

Through the song, we confess our inability to save ourselves, and our utter dependence on what Christ accomplished on the

> "Nothing good have I Whereby Thy grace to claim I'll wash my garments white In the blood of Calv'ry's Lamb. And when, before the throne, I stand in Him complete, 'Jesus died my soul to save,' My lips shall still repeat."

The refrain emphasizes the "paid in full" value of the cross.

"Jesus paid it all, All to Him I owe; Sin had left a crimson stain, He washed it white as snow."

That is the gospel of grace - that God, in love, did for us what we could not do for ourselves.

"The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

"God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son [to die in the sinner's place], that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16). Because Jesus paid it all. Tetelestai! Paid in full!

Patton's Prayer:

Dec.22, 1944

Many know the story of General Patton's prayer for better weather in order to more efficiently kill the Germans in the winter of 1944. Few know of his Christmas Greeting that was issued along with the prayer.

Contrary to popular belief, the prayer was not ordered to be written during the Battle of the Bulge. It was on the 14th of

December that General Patton had the famous exchange with Chaplain O'Neill to write a prayer for good weather and to give a copy to each member of the Third Army. The Chaplain mentioned that it's not a customary practice to pray for clear weather in order to kill fellow men.

Patton's response was direct, "Chaplain, are you teaching me theology or are you the Chaplain of the Third Army? I want a prayer."

After working out the logistics, each member of the Third Army (approximately 250,000 at the time) was issued a small card on the 22nd of December, 1944. By this time, the Battle of the Bulge was

On one side of the card was the famous prayer:

"Almighty and most merciful Father, we humbly beseech Thee, of Thy great goodness, to restrain these immoderate rains with which we have had to contend. Grant us fair weather for Battle. Graciously hearken to us as soldiers who call upon Thee that, armed with Thy power, we may advance from victory to victory, and crush the oppression and wickedness of our enemies and establish Thy justice among men and nations."

When Patton originally ordered the cards made, some of the General's men convinced him to include a Christmas greeting for the troops. It was at this time Patton took a seat at his desk beneath the contemporary ceiling fans and penned something special. On the reverse side, the card had a personal message from the General:

To each officer and soldier in the Third United States Army, I wish a Merry Christmas. I have full confidence in your

courage, devotion to duty, and skill in battle. May God's blessing rest upon each of you on this Christmas Day.

> G. S. Patton, Jr. Lieutenant General Commanding, Third United States Army

The next day, the weather cleared and remained perfect for about six days while the Third Army pushed North to relieve the 101st Airborne at Bastogne.

Upon reviewing the weather, Patton said of the Chaplain, "...Look at the weather! That O'Neill sure did some potent praying. Get him up here. I want to pin a medal on him."

The next day, the Chaplain made it to Patton's office. He shook the Chaplain's hand and said, "Chaplain, you're the most popular man in this Headquarters. You sure stand in good with the Lord and the soldiers." Chaplain O'Neill then received a Bronze Star Medal.

On Christmas Day, Patton wrote in his journal that the day 'dawned clear and cold; lovely weather for killing Germans, although the thought seemed somewhat at variance with the spirit of the day." Patton went on to write how they managed to provide every soldier with turkey. Those in the front had turkey sandwiches while everyone else had hot turkey.
